

## Embody with MM Retreat Travel Information

### Flying Into Dublin

We are a 4 hour drive from Dublin airport. Dublin is a large international airport with the most flight options and competitive prices. If flying into Dublin, the options are train or 2 bus companies that serve Dublin to Cork City. There are also 2 bus companies that serve Cork to Bantry or Skibbereen, where we will pick you up. Skibbereen is approximately 22 minutes from the property and Bantry is 15 minutes.

### From Dublin Airport To Dublin Heuston Train Station:

**Taxi** -The quickest way to get from Dublin Airport to Heuston train station is taxi. The approximate cost is €25.

**Bus** - take the bus to Dublin Heuston Station: <https://www.dublinexpress.ie/airport-to-city> €7 one way booked online, the bus from the airport to the train station picks up at Airport Terminal 1 and Terminal 2; it goes two times every hour. It is a lovely bus ride through the Dublin City Centre along the River Liffey. If you would like to see a bit of Dublin, you could plan to spend a few hours in Dublin before boarding the train.

**Train From Dublin City Centre To Cork:** Train from Dublin Heuston Station to Cork Kent Station: <https://www.irishrail.ie/en-ie/rail-fares-and-tickets/fares-info/dublin-cork>. €33 for a flexible/changeable ticket booked online. Approximate travel time is 2 1/2 hours. The train from Dublin Heuston Station to Cork Kent station goes every hour on the hour. We recommend you leave 2 or more hours between your flight arrival time into Dublin Airport and your train booking.

### Buses From Dublin Airport To Cork City:

**Aircoach:** <https://www.aircoach.ie/>. €19 one way online, from Dublin Airport Terminal 1 Zone 2 or Terminal 2 zone 20 to Cork Moodys Cafe Lower Glanmire Road, travel time: 3 hours and 30 minutes (fastest and most economical)

**Bus Eireann:** <https://www.buseireann.ie/> €38 one way, several airport stops to Cork Bus Station Parnell Place, you can also complete your travel booking from Cork City to Skibbereen or Bantry on this site.

### Bus From Cork City To Bantry or Skibbereen:

**West Cork Connect,** <https://westcorkconnect.ie/> Cork (St. Patrick's Quay Station) to Skibbereen - route 230 €11 one way, Cork to Bantry Square- route 229 €12. It is about a 7 minute walk from Cork Kent train station to St. Patrick's Quay station where you get the West Cork Connect. West Cork Connect does not service Cork Airport, but is the fastest and least expensive option from Cork City.

### Flying Into Cork Airport

Cork is about 1 and 20 minutes from the property. There are many flight options from European destinations to Cork. The buses will take you to Bantry or Skibbereen, where we will pick you up. Private transport takes you directly to the property. Please see "General Travel Tips" above for more specific information on public transportation from Cork to Bantry/ Skibbereen. **Private Transport From Cork To The House:** Skibb Taxi/West Cork Cabs <https://skibbtaxi.ie/> Direct to our property: 1-2 people €140, 3-4 people €150

From Cork Airport, you can take the Bus Éireann 225 or 226 buses to Cork City centre and Parnell Place Bus Station, the main bus station for Cork City. From there, see options above to take either West Cork Connect or Bus Eireann to Skibbereen or Bantry.

### Flying Into Shannon Airport

There are some direct transatlantic flights from the East Coast and Chicago though somewhat seasonal. Shannon airport is just under 3 hours if driving or using care hire. We are also accessible by bus. The bus goes through Cork City to Bantry or Skibbereen. Shannon Airport site: <https://www.shannonairport.ie/>

### Flying Into Kerry Airport

Kerry Airport is just under 2 hours from the property if driving or using care hire. There are limited direct flights from European destinations. If flying into Kerry, it is best to rent a car as all bus services for Bantry and Skibbereen go through Cork City, making the journey 5 hours. <https://kerryairport.ie/website/>
